SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1.0 <u>VARIATION FROM SPECIFICATIONS, INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS, OR OTHER PROVISIONS.</u>

Any request for a variation from the content of the Invitation for Bids must be made in writing to the Operations Manager no later than seven (7) calendar days prior to the date set for receipt of bids. Such request shall be considered on the basis of its merits. Only variations deemed to be in the best interest of the NETMWD will be allowed. In the event a variation is allowed, an amendment or addendum will be furnished to bidders who were supplied copies of the Invitation for Bids.

2.0 ORDERING

- (A). Supplies or services to be furnished under this contract shall be ordered by the issuance of a purchase order by the Operations Manager. Orders may be issued under this contract from October 1, 2024 or date of contract award if subsequent thereto for a period of one year.
- (B). All orders issued hereunder are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. The contract shall control in the event of conflict with any order issued pursuant to this clause.
- (C). To expedite delivery, oral orders may be placed by the Operations Manager or authorized agent provided that an purchase order number shall be provided at the time of oral placement.
- (D). The NETMWD may issue one Blanket Purchase Order to cover the contract period. Deliveries would be made referencing the Blanket Purchase Order from telephone orders.

3.0 ORDER LIMITATIONS

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(C). Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Contractor shall honor any order received which exceeds the maximum limitations set forth above unless the order or orders which exceed the maximum limitations are returned to the Operations Manager within three-days from the date of receipt thereof, together with written notice of intent not to make delivery of the items called for and the reasons thereof. Upon receipt of the notice, the NETMWD may secure the supplies from another source.

4.0 **REQUIREMENTS.**

- (A). This is a requirements contract for the supplies or service specified in the Schedule and for the period set forth in the provision entitles "Ordering" above. Delivery of supplies or performance of services shall be made only as authorized by orders issued in accordance with the "Ordering" clause. The quantities of supplies or services specified herein otherwise provided herein, in the event the NETMWD requirements for supplies or services set forth in the Schedule do not result in orders in the amounts or quantities described as "estimated" or "maximum" in the Schedule, such event shall not constitute the basis for an equitable price adjustment under this contract.
- (B). Except as otherwise provided in this contract, the NETMWD shall order from the Contractor all the supplies or services set forth in the Schedule which are required to be purchased by the Operations Manager.
- (C). Orders issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within that time shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the order. The rights and obligations of the Contractor and the NETMWD respecting those orders shall be governed by the terms of this contract to the same extent as if completed during the effective period of this contract. Provided that the Contractor shall not be required to make any deliveries under his contract after thirty (30) days following the contract period expiration date.
- (D). If delivery of any quantity of an item covered by the contract is required by reason of urgency prior to the earliest date that delivery may be specified under this contract and if the Contractor will not accept an order providing for accelerated delivery, the NETMWD may purchase this requirement from another source.
- (E). The NETMWD may issue orders which provide for delivery to or performance at multiple destinations.

5.0 PRICE ESCALATION.

The Contractor may request a price change on any contract item via WRITTEN REQUEST, showing increase in cost that necessitate the change; at least 20 calendar days before they are to take effect. The 20 days shall start on receipt by the NETMWD of such written request. The NETMWD reserves the right immediately terminate this contract and to rebid, in the event of a request for a price change.

6.0 CANCELLATION.

This contract is subject to cancellation by either part with 30 days advance written notice to the other party to comply with the provisions of this contract.

7.0 EXTENSION OF CONTRACT

This contract may be extended for an additional 12-month period if price, delivery, and terms and conditions of contract remain the same and both parties agree to this extension.

8.0 DESTINATION POINT FOR DELIVERIES.

Liquid Aluminum Sulfate furnished under this contract shall be delivered to receiving and storage facilities at either the NETMWD Tanner Plant or the NETMWD Pittsburg Plant as specified by order placed by the NETMWD.

9.0 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

SPECIFICATIONS FOR LIQUID ALUMINUM SULFATE

- 1. Shall be in liquid form.
- 2. Shall be delivered in tank trucks.
- 3. Shall be delivered to receiving and storage facilities located at the NETMWD Tanner Plant and/or NETMWD Pittsburg Plant.
- 4. Shall be in total compliance with AWWA Standard B 403-70 as listed:
 - a). Definition: Aluminum Sulfate is the basic product of the reaction between sulfuric acid and a mineral deposit rich in aluminum, such as bauxite. Liquid alum is a nearly saturated solution of aluminum sulfate.
 - b). The aluminum sulfate supplied under this standard shall contain no soluble mineral or organic substances in quantities capable of producing detrimental, deleterious or injurious effects upon public health or water quality.
 - c). Liquid alum shall be reasonably clear. It shall be of such clarity as to permit the reading of flow-measuring devices without difficulty.
 - d). Liquid alum shall contain not less than 4.25% available water soluble aluminum as A1 or 8.0% as AL203 except by agreement between the vendor and purchaser.
 - e). Water soluble alumina (AL203) in excess of the amount theoretically required to combine with the sulfuric acid (H2SO4) present, exclusive of that combined with the foreign sulfates, shall be at least 0.026% in dry aluminum sulfate and 0.013% for liquid alum.
 - f). The total water soluble iron as FE203 content of aluminum sulfate shall be no more than 0.35%, on a basis of 8.0% AL203 in liquid alum.
 - g). In Liquid alum, the suspended matter shall not exceed 0.2%.
 - h). Liquid alum shall not be produced from a waste source of aluminum oxide.

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- 5. Weight certificates shall be supplied with each delivery.
- 6. Deliveries shall be accomplished within 48 hours of receipt of telephone/ or email orders by the NETMWD.
- 7. Vendors should be aware that periodic sampling of the delivered product may be performed by the NETMWD. Substandard materials will be rejected.
- 8. Vendor shall supply to NETMWD an affidavit of compliance stating that all aluminum sulfate purchased under this contract complies with all applicable requirements of AWWA Standard B403-70.
- 9. Must be NSF60 approved, with documentation accompanying each shipment.
- 10. There is no air at either plant to facilitate unloading.
