Chosen candidate must be able to or will be trained to operate and maintain the district's water treatment plants in accordance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations. Efficiently provides safe and reliable water to NETMWD customers. Performs and or assists with a variety of physical and technical assignments.

Essential Functions

Performs numerous plant operating duties associated with the efficient operation and maintenance of the water treatment facility.

Must be able to follow guidelines and standards provided by supervisor.

Monitors, calculates and records water quality specs.

Monitors, calculates and records chemical concentration and all modifications.

Monitors and records plant operations flows, chemical dosages and, adequate storage tank capacities, backwash filter change and maintenance, instrumentation review and monitoring and facility record keeping.

Conducts preventive equipment maintenance activities that include: grease, repair, adjust, clean, paint, calibrate, lubricate, etc. plant equipment and instrumentation.

Provides facility maintenance and cleaning including sweeping and cleaning inside work areas and mowing/weed eating, etc. outside facility grounds.

Records instrument and equipment readings, making necessary calculations, records results and reports abnormal situations to supervisor and files records.

Operates Supervisory Control and Data Accession (SCADA) computer system as well as PC computers, cell phones, tablets, copiers etc.

Works on plant instrumentation as required.

Performs related duties as directed when such duties are a logical and appropriate assignment to the position.

Regular and timely attendance is required for this position.

Interacts professionally and respectfully with the public, coworkers and others in the course of daily work.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

High school diploma or equivalent is required.

Must possess a valid class "C" Surface Water certificate issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) or be able to achieve one within a year of employment.

Must be able to work at both NETMWD Plants (Avinger and Pittsburg)

Must be able to work shift work, overtime and be subject to on-call as required.

Must pass a Federal/National criminal background check. Must have a valid Texas driver's license with an acceptable driving record as defined by District's policy.
